A.

- (M)** What does Ruby like wearing to school?
- (F)** Well, she doesn't like dresses and she never wears skirts.
- (M)** And she can't wear shorts to school!
- (F)** No! She loves wearing jeans. She wears them every day.

**(tone)(pause 3 seconds)**

B.

- (M)** Where did Isaac play football yesterday? Was it at the sports centre?
- (F)** No, he never plays football at the sports centre because he doesn't live very near it.
- (M)** Did he play in his garden?
- (F)** No, his mother doesn't like him playing in the garden. She loves her plants! He sometimes plays football in the field next to the river but yesterday he played on the beach with his friends.

**(tone)(pause 3 seconds)**

C.

- (M)** What time is Kadida's music competition tomorrow?
- (F)** Well, she has a swimming lesson at half past four and the music competition is at seven o'clock.
- (M)** Ok . I can drive her to music school at five thirty.
- (F)** That's good. Then she can practise for an hour at six o'clock.

**(tone)(pause 3 seconds)**

D.

- (M)** What did Lola find in the cupboard? Was it a spider?
- (F)** No, it wasn't a spider. She screamed because it was a little mouse!
- (M)** Oh, she doesn't like mice or frogs.
- (F)** Yes, you're right she hates frogs! She's scared of butterflies too but I love them because they are pretty.

**(tone)(pause 3 seconds)**

E.

- (M)** What did Amir buy at the shopping centre?
- (F)** He wanted a new computer game but they were very expensive. Then he went to the book shop but he couldn't find any interesting books
- (M)** Oh no! Did he go to the sports shop?

(F) Yes, he went there with his brother. Amir loves running and he bought some new trainers. They're brilliant! His brother bought a nice sports bag.

(tone)(pause 3 seconds)

F.

(M) What was the weather like at the fair yesterday?

(F) Oh, it rained all day, but it wasn't windy! Mark got very wet.

(M) Oh no!

(F) He came home early because it was *really* cold but there wasn't any snow.

(M) What did Natalie eat for lunch today? I made some sandwiches but she didn't eat any of them.

(F) She wasn't very hungry - she ate a salad for lunch.

(M) Oh. She was really hungry yesterday evening. She had a big pizza and chips for dinner!

They also **love** tennis, and they play that in the summer. Usually, the **children** take their bikes to the park and sometimes they go swimming in the river. On **rainy** days, Pete stays at home and plays computer games. His favourite is an adventure game **but** his friend Jack likes the game *Red City*. It is a game about very **fast** cars. At home, Pete usually has **pasta** for lunch. He doesn't eat pizza because he hates **tomatoes**. He drinks cola or **apple** juice.

Listen to the passage about Jean and decide if the sentences are true or false. Put a tick in the correct

Jean is an actor, and she makes films for the cinema. Jean works from Monday to Friday. She stays at home at the weekend. She lives with her husband and two daughters. Jean rides a motorbike to work because she doesn't have a car. In the morning Jean starts work at 8 o'clock, and sometimes she finishes at 9 o'clock in the evening. Jean's favourite films to make are adventure films because they are exciting. Sometimes she jumps out of a helicopter or rides a horse! Jean is a great actor.
