A Strange Kind of Frogfish

The frogfish is an unusual fish, which can be quite colourful. Maybe the strangest of all is the hairy frogfish. It has long, thin pieces of skin that look like hairs all over its body. That's how it got its name. It also has wide *fins*. Most fish use their fins to swim, but the hairy frogfish doesn't use them for swimming. It uses them like legs to walk along the seafloor when it is searching for food.

It likes warm waters, such as the Indian Ocean. It doesn't live in Northern Europe because it is too cold. Some frogfish measure 50 centimetres long, but the hairy frogfish is shorter. The female usually grows to about 25 centimetres and the male only grows to about 10 centimetres. It has a huge mouth so it can feed on sea animals which are bigger than itself.

Like other sea animals, it can change colour. This means it can hide easily on the seafloor to protect itself. This also means it can catch food more easily. It can change to all the colours of the rainbow. This is why photographers love taking photos of this fish.

Sometimes frogfish open their mouths and *yawn*, like we do when we are tired. Scientists used to think they yawn when they have finished eating, but now they say it's a sign they are afraid.
