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Abstract

Moving beyond the view of culture as an “expendable fifth skill,” this presentation grew out of a simple belief: language comes alive when students have real reasons to use it. Drawing on a culture-based EFL project carried out in two Uruguayan secondary schools, it shows how theatre, storytelling, and creative reinvention can enrich everyday lessons while staying curriculum-aligned. Anglia teachers will find direct connections to the cultural themes already present in reading tasks, writing prompts, and the Step to... series, along with practical, ready-to-use ideas for their own classrooms.



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
